Mayor Coombs called the meeting to order. Doug Mabry offered prayer and Mayor Coombs led the chambers in the pledge of allegiance.

City Recorder Hucks called the roll: Mayor Coombs present, Vice Mayor Birdwell absent, Commissioner Bell present, Commissioner Duncan present, and Commissioner Young present.

Consider minutes of the July 10, 2014 regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the minutes of July 10 as written. Commissioner Duncan seconded the motion and motion passed 4-0.

Danny Turner of 1801 RiverGate Meadows Apartments expressed concerns about handicap parking at his apartment complex.

W.S. Miller of 102 Essex Ct. was complimentary about multiple city services, but then expressed concerns regarding the senior adult program meals and the program moving to the old library building.

Assistant City Manager High had some announcements:

Commissioner Duncan had comments:

Consider Ordinance No. 14-820, an ordinance to amend Title 8, Chapter 1, Section 116, Subsection 12 of the Goodlettsville Municipal Code by deleting Subsection 12 in its entirety. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 14-820. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. There was discussion and motion passed 4-0 on first reading.

Consider and possibly take action on the approval of a lease agreement for mobile computers for the police department. Commissioner Duncan made a motion to approve. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
