Mayor Duncan called the meeting to order. Doug Thornton offered prayer. Mayor Duncan led the chambers in the pledge of allegiance.

City Recorder Allison Baker called the roll: Mayor Duncan present, Vice Mayor Tinnin present, Commissioner Anderson absent, Commissioner Bell present, and Commissioner Young present.

Consider minutes of the June 27, 2019 regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners. Vice Mayor Tinnin made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion and motion passed 4-0.

City Manager Tim Ellis thanked staff for efforts regarding the 4th of July event. He stated it was a very successful event and wanted to thank them publicly.

Mayor Duncan extended condolences to the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department for the loss of Officer Anderson on behalf of the City. He also congratulated the Goodlettsville 10U All-Star Team for winning the State Championship.

Consider old business.

Consider Ordinance 19-942, an ordinance to amend the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 9, Chapter 2 in its entirety and replacing it with a new Chapter 2, as it relates to Peddlers, second reading and public hearing. Mayor Duncan opened the floor for public hearing. With no one speaking in favor or against Ordinance 19-942, the public hearing was declared closed. Vice Mayor Tinnin made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-942. Commissioner Young seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 4-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-942.

Consider new business.

Consider Ordinance 19-943, an ordinance to amend the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 7, Chapter 3 by deleting Chapter 3 in its entirety and replacing it with a new Chapter 3, as it relates to fire services, first reading. Commissioner Young made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-943. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 4-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-943.

Consider Resolution 19-856, a resolution declaring certain property surplus to the needs of the City of Goodlettsville and calling for its disposal by online auction or any other reasonable

manner. Vice Mayor Tinnin made a motion to consider Resolution 19-856. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 4-0 vote to approve Resolution 19-856.

With no further business, Commissioner Young made a motion to adjourn. Vice Mayor Tinnin seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:38 p.m. with a 4-0 vote.
