

Pleasant Green Pool Guidelines and Rules

These guidelines have been developed to assist in providing a clean, pleasant and safe environment for public swimming. At times, situations may arise that will require immediate corrective action by the lifeguards and staff based on their judgment. In those cases, the lifeguards and staff have full authority to act in order to ensure the safety of all swimmers.

General Guidelines

Admission may be denied, and any patron or user may be ejected for the following:

- Open sores, wounds, skin infection, nasal, or ear discharge
- Any condition or situation which will jeopardize the health and safety of any patron or staff
- Intoxication, or the smell of alcohol
- Under the influence of narcotics, or patron smelling of use of narcotics
- Smoking

The following are not permitted:

- Running and Horseplay
- Abusive or Profane language
- Glass containers or breakable containers
- Unattended children under the age of 13
- Prolonged breath holding
- Public displays of affection
- Animals, with the exception of service animals
- Thongs, g-strings, denim, shorts or suits that are not proper swimwear.

Please help us with the following;

- Use receptacles for all trash
- Do not litter
- Report any injuries to staff immediately
- Not engaging in unnecessary conversation with lifeguards
- Adhering to pool rules

Pool Rules

Staff reserves the right to administer a swim test to any patron.

- No back dives or flips from the side of the pool
- No hanging on lifeline
- No diving on the shallow side of the lifeline
- Do not block ladders
- During high attendance, flippers, beach balls, rubber rafts, and other inflatable items will be permitted at the discretion of the lifeguards
- Spitting, spouting of water from the mouth, or nose blowing is not permitted.
- Shower before entering the pool
- No one with open sores or cuts allowed in the pool
- Children 3 and under and anyone who wears diapers must wear swimming diapers when entering the pool
- Anyone who has had diarrhea within the last two weeks is not permitted in the pool.

Diving Area Rules

- Make sure diving area is clear before jumping or diving
- Diving and jumping is permitted in a forward direction from the end of the board only
- One bounce only on boards
- One person on a diving board at a time
- Leave the diving area immediately after entering the water
- Do not swim under or between boards
