# LAND DISTURBANCE PERMIT

#### Instructions

This permit must be applied for at: Goodlettsville Stormwater Department, 318 N. Main Street, Goodlettsville, TN 37072. Phone 615 851-3462.

### Purpose of this form:

To eliminate any non-allowable discharges to Goodlettsville's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) that impact water quality.

<u>Completing the form:</u> Type or print clearly, using ink and not markers or pencil. Initial each blank item and make a check mark in the boxes signifying that you have read these sections and will comply with them. Submitting this **Land Disturbance Permit** does not exempt you from complying with all aspects of the city of Goodlettsville's *Stormwater Management Ordinance*. This form does not exempt you from obtaining any other state, local or federal required permits.

## Who must submit a Land Disturbance Permit form?

Any one that is disturbing more than one acre of land use.

### No site development permit is required for the following activities:

- Any emergency activity that is immediately necessary for the protection of life, property, or natural resources.
- Agricultural land management activities (except where the clearing of the land, forest or other agriculture activity, results in activities other than further agriculture or forest use).
- Additions or modifications to existing detached single-family dwellings.
- Developments that do not disturb more than one acre of land use. This exception may not be applied for contiguous properties that may have been subdivided and/or are attributed to multiple separate owners. This exemption does not apply to any discharge of sediment or other form of water pollution that may leave a small site.

### Other permits:

An **ARAP permit** may be required. If your work will disturb or cause alterations of a stream or wetland, you must obtain an appropriate Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (ARAP) before you will receive a City of Goodlettsville Land Disturbance Permit. If you have a question about the ARAP program or permits, contact your local Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation Environmental Assistance Center.

If you are disturbing more than **1 acre** you will also need a **NPDES Permit** from TDEC; you will need to have it and supply a copy before obtaining a Goodlettsville Land Disturbance Permit.
